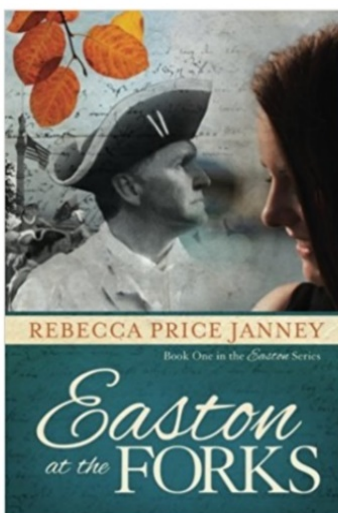

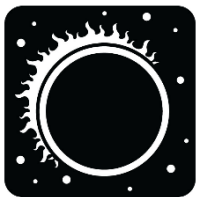
Browse the Book Nook for "Hidden Gems"

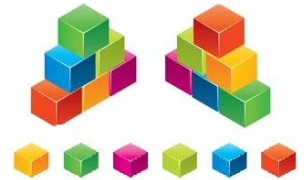
Toddler Rhythm at Library
