

The Friends of the Easton Area Public Library is sponsoring a bus trip on Saturday, May 27, to the Chihuly Experience at the New York Botanical Garden.

The Chihuly Experience will feature the artwork of world-renowned sculptor Dale Chihuly with monumental installations in the Garden's landscape and architecture. For more information about the exhibit, visit <http://www.nybg.org/exhibitions/2017/chihuly/>.

The bus will board at 8:45 am and leave the Main Library at 9:00. Arrival at the NYBG is around 11:30 am. A guide will meet us and take us to lunch via the tram. We'll dine in the Stone Mill, a national historic landmark. A box lunch is included in the price; choices are a turkey club sandwich, tomato and mozzarella on a sourdough baguette, or a grilled chicken Cobb salad plus a piece of fruit, potato chips, chocolate chip cookies, and bottled water.

After lunch we'll tour the Chihuly exhibit via the tram. After the tour, we'll have free time to explore the gardens or view the exhibit of Chihuly drawings in the Mertz Library's Art Gallery or exhibits on herbs or plants and fungi. The Haupt Conservatory, a stunning example of a Victorian style glasshouse, is showcasing "A World of Plants." Departure is at 4:00 pm with estimated arrival in Easton at 6:00 pm. The Library is closed that day, so there is plenty of free, off-street parking.
