

# Library Bus Trip to the Lower East Side Tenement Museum & Governor's Island

## Saturday, May 19, 2018

Come join us on Saturday, May 19 for a guided tour of the Lower East Side Tenement Museum. You will have a choice of visiting the Italian Apartment on the second floor or the Irish Apartment on the fifth floor. Hear the stories of immigrants who started their lives anew on Manhattan's Lower East Side between the 19th & 21st centuries through the recreated apartments and businesses of real families in two historic tenement buildings. Take time and stop in at the Tenement Museum Shop where you can pick up a souvenir of your visit.

Afterwards we will take the ferry to Governors Island where there are food courts, picnic areas and historic sites to explore. There is much to do on this picturesque island: stroll along, rent a bicycle, relax at Hammock Grove, hike the Hills and enjoy the views, then play on the four slides at Slide Hill.



We will meet at the William Penn Park & Ride and leave at 8:00 am. Estimated return time is 6:00 pm.
