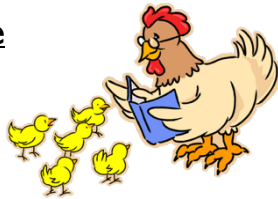

Booker the Library Elf is back!

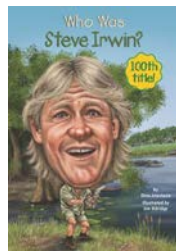
